Residents' Rights: An Overview

Residents' Rights are guaranteed by the federal 1987 Nursing Home Reform Law. The law requires nursing homes to "promote and protect the rights of each resident" and places a strong emphasis on individual dignity and self-determination. A person living in a long-term care facility maintains the same rights as an individual in the larger community.

The Right to Be Fully Informed of:

Available services and the charges for each service

- ② Facility rules and regulations, including a written copy of resident rights
- ② Address and telephone number of the State Ombudsman and state survey agency
- State survey reports and the nursing home's plan of correction
- Advance plans of a change in rooms or roommates
- Assistance if a sensory impairment exists
- Residents have a right to receive information in a language they understand (Spanish, Braille, etc.)

Right to Complain... Voice Concerns
Right to Participate in One's Own Care
Right to Privacy and Confidentiality
Rights During Transfers and Discharges
Right to Dignity, Respect, and Freedom
Right to Having Visitors
Right to Make Independent Choices

Bloomsbury Farm began as a greenhouse and landscaping business in 1995. Owner Karen Petersen had a degree in Floriculture, and after working in the floral industry for a while, decided she wanted to run her own business, doing something she enjoyed.
