BUCHANAN COUNTY HEALTH CENTER AUXILIARY HEALTH CAREER SCHOLARSHIP

General

The Buchanan County Health Center Auxiliary is offering six \$1,000 scholarships to assist Buchanan County residents pursuing a career in the human health care field.

- ◆ Three \$1,000 scholarships are available for high school seniors at East Buchanan, Independence, and Jesup High Schools. A student from each high school is eligible for the scholarship if he/she plan to pursue a human health care career. Application process is through Dollars for Scholars at each of the Buchanan County high schools.
- Two \$1,000 scholarships are available for non-traditional students fulfilling eligibility requirements. Non-traditional students from Buchanan County or who work in Buchanan County pursuing a human health care career may apply. Special consideration will be given to students who have returned to school after working a few years and/or caring for family.
- One \$1,000 scholarship will be available to a student from Buchanan County already attending a higher education institution, pursuing a degree in a human health care field.

Eligibility

- Applicant must be a resident of <u>or work in</u> Buchanan County. Special consideration may be given to those working at the Buchanan County Health Center.
- Applicant must be accepted into an institution of higher learning with the objective of entering a human healthcare field recognized by members of the Buchanan County Health Center Auxiliary.

Requirements of the BCHC Auxiliary Form

- One non-family member of the applicant's community needs to write a letter of recommendation.
- ◆ A transcript of most recent grades and SAT or ACT composite scores (if available) should accompany the BCHC application.
- Descriptive paper that includes ways applicant has been involved in the community and reasons why he/she should be considered for this scholarship.
