### **Taste of Home**



Prep Time: 15 mins

### Ingredients

- 1/4 cup light brown sugar, packed
- 1/2 cup white sugar
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 2 teaspoons ground cinnamon
- 1 teaspoon ground ginger
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cloves
- 1 teaspoon nutmeg
- 1 tablespoon pure vanilla extract
- 2 large eggs
- 1 (15 ounce) cans Libby's canned pumpkin
- 1 (12 fluid ounce) cans Carnation Evaporated Milk
- 1 unbaked 9-inch deep dish pie pastry (4 cup volume)

### Directions

- 1. Mix sugars, salt and spices in a large bowl.
- 2. Beat eggs in small bowl and pour into sugar/spice mixture.
- 3. Empty can of pumpkin into sugar/spice mixture.
- Mix everything with a wooden spoon or a wire whip, use a rubber spatula to incorporate all ingredients.
   Add evaporated milk gradually and continue stirring.

Pour into pie shell.

Bake in preheated oven at 425 degrees F. for 15 minutes. Reduce temperature to 350 degrees F. and bake for an additional 40-45 minutes, or until toothpick inserted in center comes out clean.

### About This Pumpkin Pie Recipe

"A traditional pumpkin pie recipe with kicked up flavor. It is similar to the recipe on the Libby's Pumpkin can, with the addition of extra spices, some brown sugar, and vanilla extract to make it extra flavorful."



To our Family Members and Friends,

Long-term care facilities continue to be dramatically impacted by COVID-19. 165 of lowa's 432 long-term care facilities have had a confirmed COVID-19 outbreak. COVID-19 has had a disproportionate impact to long-term care residents due to their congregate nature and often elder population who are at increased risk of contracting and being impacted by this virus. As such, the long-term care restrictions that have been put in place by regulatory agencies continue to be necessary to protect our residents.

We have been testing all staff for COVID-19 each week effective September 29<sup>th</sup>. We have had a total of one employee test positive, which was already announced in August. No residents have tested positive.

To decrease the risk of a COVID-19 outbreak, we have continued our mitigation measures. We are making some changes though due to the length of time we will be dealing with COVID-19. We will be increasing therapy services and welcomed the return of the beautician in early October. In addition, we increased the number of residents attending communal dining and activities. While residents are spread out for dining, for further protection we added plexi-glass guards at each table.

With the holidays approaching, I know you are wondering how the restrictions at Lexington Estate will impact your loved ones. We will be expanding our visitor booth hours for the week of Thanksgiving to include Wednesday 9:00A to 12:45P, Thursday 10:00A to 3:00P, and Saturday 10:00A to 4:00P. We are also evaluating additional hours each weekend. Please contact Dianne Hepke, Activities Coordinator, with any questions or requests for special accommodations at (319) 332-0914. In addition, Dan McElroy will be offering counseling services to residents. Dan is a licensed social worker and provides counseling services for Buchanan County Health Center.

Although we understand that not being with your loved one during the holidays is especially difficult, we strongly discourage anyone from taking their loved one out of the facility. Each time a resident leaves their risk of contracting COVID-19 significantly increases, which may spread to other residents. In the event a resident does leave they will need to be quarantined for 14 days. In the event several residents leave, we will need to make room changes to cohort those residents.

We understand that this is a very difficult time. Our activities and other team members are working to find additional ways to decrease the impact of restrictions, especially throughout the holidays. In late November we will review any potential changes for Christmas.

We appreciate your continued support to keep all residents of Lexington Estate safe. Please reach out to myself or another team member if you have any questions or concerns.
