#### Taste of Home

St. Patty's Day Oreo Bark

#### **Ingredients:**

2 cups semi-sweet chocolate chips
2 cups white chocolate chips
1 ½ cups crushed Oreo cookies (mint or double stuff) measure after crushed
½ cup green m&m's
green sprinkles

#### Instructions:

Line a cookie baking sheet with parchment paper.

Microwave semi-sweet chocolate chips in a microwaveable safe bowl at 30- second intervals.

Spread melted semi-sweet chocolate out onto prepared baking sheet.

Sprinkle crushed Oreos over melted semi-sweet chocolate.

Allow to cool at least 10 minutes before adding white chocolate.

Microwave white chocolate in a microwaveable safe bowl at 30-second intervals, stirring after each interval (or use a double broiler to melt chocolate.)

Then pour/spread melted white chocolate over the Oreo layer.

Sprinkle the top with M&Ms and sprinkles, then let cool completely.



## ST. PATRICK'S DAY

#### Thursday, MARCH 17TH WEAR GREEN

St. Patrick's Day was first celebrated in America in 1737, organized by the charitable Irish Society of Boston, including a feast and religious service.

This holiday is celebrated every year on March 17th, honoring the Irish patron saint, St. Patrick. People all over the world celebrate St. Patrick's Day, especially those in large Irish communities. Cities that hold large parades are: Boston, New York, Philadelphia, New Orleans, Savannah, and other cities worldwide.

There are many legends associated with St. Patrick. The symbol of the shamrock used for St. Patrick's Day comes from the story of St. Patrick using the shamrock to illustrate the Holy Trinity.

Early celebrations continued after the charitable Irish Society of Boston. In New York, the first celebration took place as a small gathering at the house of an Irish protestant. St. Patrick's Day parades started in New York in 1762 by a small group of Irish soldiers in the Boston military.

Parades and wearing green have always been a traditional part of St. Patrick's Day Celebrations. Chicago dyes its river green for the festivities. The White House fountain is also dyed green.


